

Wise disciples diligently prepare themselves for the Master's coming, heeding the call to grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord. Fools are complacent, trusting that the little they have done will suffice as "preparation." (2Peter 3:18; 15-8)

Wise disciples, knowing what is to come, "look" for it and live accordingly. Fools know the Lord is coming, but aren't preparing themselves or making "extra preparations." (2 Peter 3:14-16)

Wise disciples prepare for his waiting such that be it a short wait or a long wait, he is very much ready. Fools become drowsy and fall asleep and after that awaken unprepared. (Hebrews 6:11)

APPLICATION:

2. As disciples of Christ, how should we now think of being prepared for the Lord's return?

• Wise disciples put their salvation with highest regard and protects that salvation knowing that it is gift from God that cost the life of His one and only begotten Son. The one who doesn't will suffer. (Proverbs 9:12)

• Wise disciples maintain that they cannot depend and trust on relationships or associations (parents, spouse, religious affiliation, etc.) for salvation. Remember that we only can blame our own selves if we don't get to enter the pearly gates. (Rev 20:12-15)

• Wise disciples recognize fully know that they cannot impart what salvation they have received to someone else nor can he be saved on the final Judgment Day by those who are well-prepared. (Psalm 49:7)

3. As disciples of Christ, how can we maintain a state of preparedness?

• Wise disciples are careful not to let this world preoccupy them through its worldly lusts and worldly concerns. (Luke 21:34-35)

• Wise disciples are steadfast in prayer for in prayer we naturally maintain an attitude of watchfulness. Also, in prayer we can be sure we will be counted worthy as we confess our sins. (Eph 6:18; 1 Jn 1:9)

• Wise disciples are diligent in growing in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ - making every effort to increase in faith, and so be all the more eager to make our calling and election sure and thereby receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (2 Pe 3:8; 2 Pe 1:5-8; 1 Pe 1:10-11)
