

y favorite verses to begin any Year from Lamentations 3:19-24. have given you three lations for this passage. Each one brings new things to light and causes us to begin this year anew for the Lord with great Hope.

"Remember my affliction and my wanderings, the wormwood and the gall! <sup>20</sup> My soul continually remembers it and is bowed down within me.<sup>21</sup> But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope:<sup>22</sup> The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; <sup>23</sup> they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. 24 "The Lord is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him." (ESV)

"The thought of my suffering and homelessness is bitter beyond words.<sup>20</sup> I will never forget this awful time, as I grieve over my loss. 21 Yet I still dare to hope when I remember this: 22 The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. 23 Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. <sup>24</sup> I say to myself, "The Lord is my inheritance: therefore. I will hope in him!" (NLT)

<sup>19-21</sup> I'll never forget the trouble, the utter lostness, the taste of ashes, the poison I've swallowed. I remember it all—oh. how well I remember—the feeling of hitting the bottom. But there's one other thing I remember, and remembering, keep a grip on hope:

<sup>22-24</sup> God's loyal love couldn't have run come out, his merciful love couldn't have dried up. They're created new every morning. trans- How great your faithfulness! I'm sticking with God (I say it over and over). He's all I've got left. (MSG)

> The people of Israel were rebelling against God and Jeremiah felt that deeply as he sought to speak to the people about God. The prophet Jeremiah, had seen and experienced great hardship both physically and spiritually. In spite of trials, will you like Jeremiah place your trust and hope in the Lord? "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." (1 Peter 2:9-10). THROUGH CHRIST WE HAVE RECEIVED GOD'S GREATEST MERCY.

> If you don't feel His mercy in the midst of your turmoil, turn to Him and ask Him for insight to see where He is being merciful to you. No place else can we get that assurance and hope. He alone is faithful and will give us new mercies each and every morning. Sending Jesus was God's greatest gift of mercy towards us, and so begin this New Year with thanksgiving on your lips. Walk the next 365 days with the Lord and experience His mercies each and every morning! Happy New Year!
