

Those who love themselves more than they love the Lord God and who refuse to carry their crosses cannot be a disciple. Jesus warns that discipleship is equivalent to a cross, a one-way journey, there's no turning back, a death to self but alive in Christ for in fact, it took the death of Jesus for us to be saved. 2. Let us consider the PREPARATION required of being a disciple of Christ. Jesus requires that we prepare by cooperating with God's terms alone since we, on our own, don't have what it takes to be in a battle. 3. Let us consider the PREPSEVERANCE required in being a disciple of Christ. Jesus requires us to persevere in discharging our duties, in demonstrating Christ-like attitude, and in fulfilling the great commission.
